

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT PHOTO CONTEST “PEOPLE AND THE MEDITERRANEAN”

CONTEST TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The contest is open to all student amateur or professional photographers.
- There is no fee for participating in the exhibition.
- Each entrant can submit up to 4 photos - any technique, black/white or color.
- Photo manipulations in Adobe Photoshop may include solely altering a photo's cropping, tone and color processing, removing dust from sensors and other small elements. Changing the content of the photo itself is not permitted.
- Photos are sent in digital form; the length of the photo page must be at least 5000 pixels. Files are sent as a .jpeg file a maximum of 4MB in size.
- The organizer will create the photographs selected for exhibiting in the format 50 × 70 cm
- The photos should be sent exclusively by electronic mail, to info@mic-vis.eu with the message subject line "Photo Contest People and the Mediterranean".
- In addition to the photographs, each contestant is also required to send a completed application form in Croatian or English (which can be downloaded [here](#)) with his / her name and photo information.
- Each photo must include the photographer's name and the name of the photo.
- Each entrant's file size should not exceed 16MB.
- By signing and submitting the application form the entrant accepts the organizer's terms and conditions so that the selected photographs can be used for reproduction in the catalog and publication for the purpose of promoting the contest, exhibition and scientific conference MIC - Vis at no extra charge. The organizer of the photo contest will not use the entered photographs for any purpose other than promoting the exhibition and scientific conference. The organizer will publish photos with photographer's names stated.
- Photographers participating in the exhibition will receive an e-catalog, and their prizes and recognitions will be awarded. The WEB catalog will be delivered to the e-mail address of each exhibitor. Prizes will be awarded at the opening of the exhibition and submitted by mail.
- The submitted photos will be judged by a three-member jury, who will also award three contestants of the best photos.
